Supplementary Information

The purpose of Grant Aid is to support community groups who actively seek to promote the wellbeing of the residents of Darley Dale. The Town Council wishes to promote and enable community activities which encourage cooperation and involvement for all.

To apply for a grant from the Town Council you must be either a registered local charity or a local community group with a bank account and constitution.

Please refer to the notes below as a general guidance to evaluate whether a grant application is appropriate for your particular group or association.

Grant Aid can be applied for :

- 1 Supporting specific user groups in their activities (eg young children's groups, Youth work, the elderly and groups with special needs).
- 2 Assisting in the purchase of equipment or materials to support specific communal activities (eg IT equipment, sports kit, sports equipment).
- 3 Assisting with modest infrastructure projects which enable community activities (eg minor building works or repairs).
- 4 The purchase of specific services to enhance organised community activity (eg visiting speakers, entertainment or specified educational activity).
- 5 Supporting projects that will leave a lasting legacy for the community to use or enjoy (eg play spaces for children, seating garden areas, improvements to allotment sites, improvements to immediate Town environment).
- 6 Start up costs for new project or club.
- 7 Costs associated with enlarging an existing club membership.

Grant aid is **not** available to meet legal costs, rent, entertainment or travel or accommodation costs. It is also not available to pay salaries or out of pocket expenses for the organisation's volunteers.
