Notice of a Drop-in Session

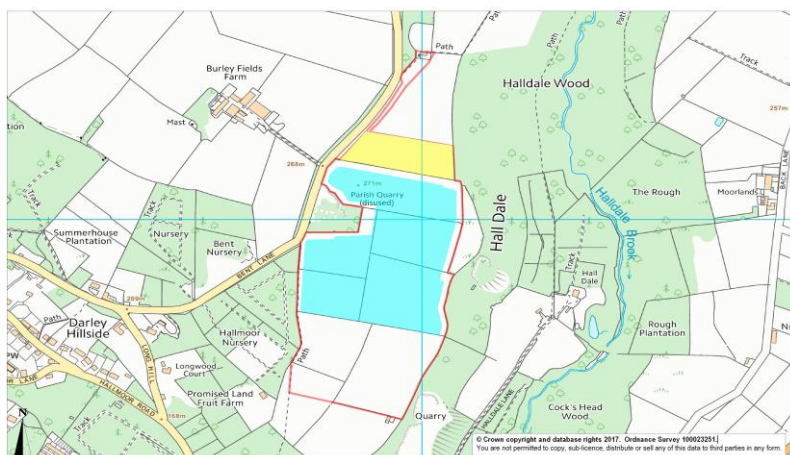
The Whitworth Centre

Derbyshire County and Derby City Council are preparing a joint Minerals Local Plan for the part of Derbyshire outside the Peak District National Park. It will set out how much, where and when new mineral working will be required over the Plan period to 2030. It will include policies to control the potential impacts of working and it will also identify specific sites for future mineral working. Policies in the Plan will be used to determine planning applications for mineral development.

In your area, one site; a proposal for a new **building stone quarry at Bent Lane, Darley Dale** has been put forward for working by Stancliffe Stone Company Ltd, as shown on the map below. All sites put forward must be assessed to determine whether they are suitable to be included in the Plan. The Councils are currently carrying out a consultation which includes an initial assessment of this site, details of which can be found at the following webpage:
